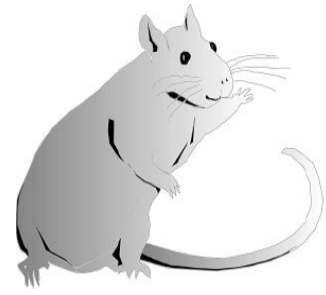

All entries are \$20/per run.

Entries:

\$20.00 per run. All entry forms must be accompanied by entry fee payment to be valid. There will be a \$50.00 fee for all returned checks.

No day of trial entries; advance registration with payment must be received by *June 22, 2026*. Trial will be limited to 176 runs per day (including club dog runs).

NOTES:

*Entries are extremely limited with only 1 judge and the potential for each dog to run in 4 Classes (1 Regular & 3 Games)

*Run order will be emailed out to you 48 hours prior to trial date

*Only 1 dog runs at a time

*All your dog's runs are back to back

*All Qualifying Ribbons, Perfect Day Ribbons & New Title Ribbons are picked up immediately

*Placement Ribbons & Judge's Award Ribbons are awarded at the end of each trial

*Expect about 4 hours between your run in Trial 1 and your run in Trial 2

Bitches in season are eligible for entry but will be required to be kept separate from all other dogs, will be run at the end of their class/trial, and must wear "panties" while competing. Entry fees for bitches that come into season will be refunded until the time of the trial if you wish to withdraw. If

bringing a bitch in season, please inform the trial secretary prior to the trial and inform all exhibitors at the judge's briefing.

This trial will be held indoors, with air conditioning and a crating area available. Please bring your own crate, chair and towels, blankets or tarps to cover the floor area of your setup.

There is ample space outdoors to potty dogs and ask that you please pick up after your dogs and respectfully utilize the potty trash areas outside the building. (No dirty poop bags in indoor trash please)

The theme for this trial will be RATATOUILLE!!! This is a Disney movie about a rat named Remy becoming a chef in Paris, so feel free to decorate your crate, dress up, or otherwise represent the theme. Let's have funnnn!

Food will also be available and cooked fresh! Chicken legs, chicken thighs, sausage, hot dogs, salad, brownies and drinks.

Plus Raffles! There will be a number of different raffles to choose from. And when you volunteer, you get entered into a basket of your choosing. Simply indicate on your entry form if you'd like to volunteer and in what capacity: Gate stewards, time keeper, rat wrangler, setup, clean up. THANK YOU in advance!!

Ribbons:

Green Flat Ribbons = Qualifying Scores In Regular/Standard Classes

Hot Pink Flat Ribbons = Qualifying Scores In Games

Rosettes = 1st - 4th Place Awarded In All Regular Classes & Games

New Title Rosette = Awarded To Those Who Earn Enough Points In Their Class/Game To Move On To The Next Level

Perfect Day Rosette = Awarded To Those Who Have Qualified In 100% Of The Classes They Have Entered (Choice Of 2 Color Options)

Judge's Award Rosette = Goes To Only 1 Dog Per Trial Of The Judge's Choosing

Prizes:

Special dog treats, chews and/or dog drinks will be given with placement rosettes.

Placement punchcards will be given with all placement ribbons as well. Get 10 placements and earn a free entry!
